MOUNT ROYAL MUSIC STAFF

Dr. H. Jones received his doctorate of music from McGill University. He was band director of the Canadian Grenadier Guards and McGill University. He organized and was the first director of the Alouette Football Band. More than any other individual, he is responsible for the development of music in Montreal schools. For fourteen years he organized and directed the Mount Royal Music Festival in which most high schools throughout Montreal and from the United States participated.

Mr. J. Miceli studied at the Toronto Conservatory of Music. He has since had a distinguished career as the conductor of various bands and orchestras throughout Canada. During World War II he was bandmaster of the R.C.A.F., and from 1961 to 1965 was warrant officer of the first class and the band conductor of the Grenadier Guards. At present, in addition to his position as a teacher, he has three bands of his own—The Philharmonic of Lachine, The Philharmonic of St. Hyacinthe, and The Army, Navy and Airforce Veterans' Band.

Mr. H. Wagschal studied violin at the Julliard School of Music in New York and at Brandeis University in Boston. In 1961 he was awarded a Canada Council Grant to study at the Vienna Academy of Music in Austria. While in Europe he won a scholarship from the French Embassy in Canada to continue his studies in France. He has performed with various orchestral groups both in Europe and in Canada, including the "Ensemble Français de Tours", the C.B.C. Symphony and Radio Orchestra, and the Quebec Symphony Orchestra.
